Y7 TRIP TO TUDOR HOUSE, SOUTHAMPTON FRIDAY 13th DECEMBER 2024

Leaving: 08:30

Returning: 15:15 (traffic dependant) **Transport:** Coach

Cost: £20.00 to be paid on SCOPAY before 15th November 2024.

By making this payment you are giving consent for your child to attend this trip. There are a limited number of places, therefore payment will constitute booking and will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Clothing: Students will need to be in full college uniform.

Food: Bring a packed lunch.

Packed lunches can be purchased from the canteen at 8am prior to registration for the trip. Students in receipt of free school meals can collect packed lunches from the canteen at that time.

Description: Tudor House is Southampton's most important historic building, revealing over 800 years of history in one fascinating location. The house was built in the late 15th Century, with King John's Palace, an adjacent Norman house accessible from Tudor House Garden, dating back a further 300 years. Visiting the house will support the student's study of the Tudor period and medieval history by allowing them to place themselves in this exciting period of history.

Final decision regarding the students travelling will be made by the Senior Leadership Team and Head of Achievement. They will continue to monitor behaviour records, punctuality and effort, in order to ensure that our offer is fair for all students. Students selected will be expected to maintain a high standard of behaviour; failure to do so may put their place in jeopardy.
